INVITATION FOR THE SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR 3 x AIRSTRIP PROJECT ENGINEERS FOR CIVIL AVIATION DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT PROJECT II (CADIP II) Loan Nos. 4276/4277

The Independent State of Papua New Guinea has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of Civil Aviation Development Investment Project II. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above.

The **National Airports Corporation** ("the Employer") invites Expression of Interest from eligible national individual consultants especially project engineers for the Civil Aviation Development Investment Project II (CADIP II).

OBJECTIVE

To provide additional capacity and expertise to assist the Department of Transport (DoT) and NAC CADIP II Project Implementation Unit (PIU) in implementing the Pilot Rural airstrip projects in Papua New Guinea (namely Finschhafen, Hayfield and Jacquinet Bay Airstrips).

DETAILED SCOPE FOR THE CONSULTANCY SERVICES

Reporting to the Project Manager, the Project engineers shall assist with the implementation of the three selected pilot Airstrip rehabilitation projects in PNG. More specifically, the Project engineer will undertake the following:

1 Procurement Management:

- Oversee the procurement process for construction materials and services, ensuring strict adherence to guidelines and regulatory requirements in collaboration with the NAC PIU and DoT to ensure the successful and execution of the 3 pilot airstrip projects;

2 Construction Supervision:

- Undertake on-site supervision and monitoring during the construction phase,
- Ensure all construction activities align precisely with the approved designs and specifications.
- Address contractual and technical issues promptly, and ensure compliance with safety standards,
- Maintain high-quality standards throughout the construction process.

3 Stakeholder Engagement:

- Collaborating effectively with internal and external stakeholders, including architects, engineers, contractors, and regulatory bodies and address technical concerns and obtain necessary approvals to contribute to the smooth progress of the projects.

4 Budget Management:

- Assisting in the development of project budgets and monitoring expenses related to the projects,
- Assist with cost control measures and efficient resource allocation.

5 Reporting:

- Preparing regular reports on the progress of projects for review by DOT and NAC,
- Deliver comprehensive project updates and presentations as required.
- Completed and updated succinct work plan (2026-2027);
- Monthly Progress Reports

6 Continuous Improvement:

- Undertake a continual evaluation of construction processes and outcomes to identify areas for improvement,
- Implement strategies to enhance efficiency and effectiveness, foster a culture of continuous improvement within the project team,

7 Other Duties:

Perform other duties as and when directed by the Project Manager in line with the overall objectives of CADIP II and ensure the successful delivery of projects.

• REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TOR

- Bachelor's degree in Civil engineering or similar discipline;
- IEPNG membership is highly desirable;
- Minimum of 5 years work experience in the field of construction project management
- Experience in Airstrips or Airport project implementation will be an advantage
- Experiences in implementing donor-funded projects is desirable
- Conversant with AUTO-CAD and MS project Office suite;
- Familiar with ICAO, FAA and CASA Rules and Regulations.

- Duration of engagement is for 18 months.


