- Ensuring management be responsible for safety risk management by providing the necessary resources to achieve the effective operation of our Safety Management System across all activities.
- Clearly defining for all staff their accountabilities and responsibilities for the delivery of the organization's safety performance and the performance of the Safety Management System
- Establishing and operating a Hazard Identification and Risk Management Process to mitigate safety risks
- Continuously improving safety at all our airports through monitoring, measurement and review
- Ensuring that sufficient skilled and trained personnel are available to implement safety strategies and processes
- Ensuring that relevant aviation safety information is communicated to all staff and aviation stakeholders to promote safety awareness and address safety issues

Ultimate responsibility for safety in the company rests with myself as the accountable executive. Individually and collectively, all employees have a role and responsibility in providing a safe, healthy and productive workplace for ourselves, and a safe and efficient service to our customers.
